## Moroso Aluminum Power Steering Tank (05-10 GT, V6)

## **Required Tools:**

- Slip-joint pliers
- 8MM socket / wrench
- Flathead Screwdriver
- Turkey Baster
- Car Floor Jack
- 2 Jack Stands

## **Installation Instructions:**

- 1. Remove fluid from the stock power steering tank. This can be accomplished with a Turkey Baster.
- 2. Remove single bolt on power steering tank, an 8MM wrench/socket can be used to remove the Bolt.





NOTE: Have a small container to catch any fluid from power steering lines.

3. Disconnect two lines from power steering tank. This can be accomplished using the Slip-joint pliers.

NOTE You may need to use the Flathead Screwdriver to loosen the line from the Tank.



- 4. Remove power steering tank.
- 5. Connect two lines to new power steering tank.




6. Install single bolt on new power steering tank. Tighten using 8MM wrench/socket.



7. Fill new power steering tank with power steering fluid 1/2 inch from the top.

## BLEED AIR FROM POWER STEERING.


- 8. Jack the front wheels off the ground just enough to turn the wheel freely.
- 9. Remove cap from new power steering tank.



NOTE

**Do Not Start Engine** 

- 10. With engine NOT running, turn the steering wheel all the way to right and back all the way to the left 30 to 40 times.
- 11. Lower front wheels back to the ground.
- 12. Install cap on new power steering tank.



13. Start the engine. Make sure the new Tank and lines are not leaking.
