

Tools required

- 1. Razor knife
- 2. Flathead screwdriver

Installation:

- 1. Unscrew and remove the shift knob.
- 2. Lift up on the chrome trim which holds the boot in place and remove it from the center console.
- 3. Release the 3 prongs on the reverse lockout collar which attach the boot to the shifter.
- 4. Using a flathead screwdriver gently pry the bottom of the stock reverse lockout collar apart, this is held together by glue from the factory and will release it from the shift boot.

- 5. With the shift boot freed, use the razor knife to carefully remove one stitch at a time until you are able to turn the boot inside out and push the Steeda reverse lockout collar through the bottom of the boot as shown.
- 6. Use the provided low profile zip tie to secure the boot around the lockout collar.
- 7. Install the provided o-ring into the o-ring groove in the top of the lockout collar.

- 8. Slide the Steeda collar over the shifter and snap it into place on the factory reverse lockout. If installing this piece with our Steeda Tri-Ax, simply tighten the three set screws to secure the collar.
- 9. Snap the factory chrome trim back into place on the center console.
- 10. Screw your shift knob back onto the shift lever making sure not to over tighten the unit as the chrome centerpiece can be pressed out.
